Source of Grapes

Our Öküzgözü vineyard is located in the Elmalı district of Antalya in the Mediterranean Region, at an altitude of 1200m. Our Cabernet Franc vineyard is in the Kaynaklar village of Buca, south of Izmir. It is located at an altitude of 235m. The vines are cultivated in a cordon system and sustainable viticulture practices are maintained in both vineyards.

Dates Harvested

Cabernet Franc was harvested on the 13th September, Öküzgözü was harvested on the 13th October 2021.

Winemaking

The grapes were handpicked, destemmed and crushed. Fermentation took place in stainless steel tank with skin contact of 3 weeks with pumping overs. It was then matured in French oak barrels for 6 months and aged in bottles.

Tasting Notes

Ruby colour with purple highlights. Vivid fruits on the nose like raspberry, sweet red cherry, black pepper and mint flavors. The fresh fruit character with rounded tannins is highlighted in the palate with medium body. Its velvety texture provides a joyful finish.
